Missing child-Jerusalem

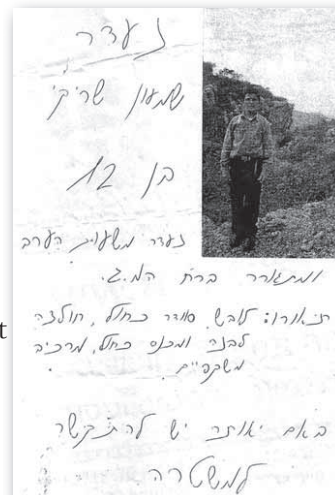
Hundreds of volunteers searched for a 12 year old who went missing from his parent's house in Jerusalem this past Friday night.

The volunteers who assisted the police went searching with private vehicles along side ambucycles and by foot as well.

Photos of the child were handed out all over Jerusalem and a sound truck calling his name was sent out finally at Shabbat afternoon almost 12 hours after the search began.

The 12 year old was later found safe and sound in the neighborhood of Bayit Vegan.

We wish to send a big Thank you to all the volunteers who left their families on Shabbat and searched all night for the missing boy.



Accident - road 446

A young Palestinian who was stopped at a check point in the entrance to Jerusalem tried to flee from the solders when he was hit by a passing car.

The boy ran into the street not looking to see if it was clear, he was hit and was severely injured.

The emergency call came out as an accident involving many injurious, 10 united Hatzalah volunteers arrived at the scene not sure as to the severity of the accident and the amount of people involved.

When they arrived they started immediately CPR on the Palestinian. They worked on him for over an hour but he was eventually pronounced dead.

Jerusalem, Eilat-not so far apart

Eli Jakobie, united Hatzalah volunteer from Jerusalem was visiting a student in Eilat all this part of his "big brother" work.

Eli was listening to the national Hatzalah radio wave when he heard the emergency call of a 60 year old unconscious in the center of Eilat. Eli ran to the call only to discover that the dedicated volunteers of Eilat were already on the scene.

He assisted them with CPR, using the brand new defibrillator they had just received and after 50 minuets the man was in stable condition and was transferred to the hospital.

A very unique agreement

A very unique agreement between employer and employee was signed this past week, the agreement was as follows : the employee - a United Hatzalah volunteer can leave work at any time to save lives all -at the bosses expense but in return 50% of the merit of his life saving work will go to the boss...

Yussie Hakar- is known in Jerusalem for his meat shop where many of the Jerusalem people shop, yussie has recently signed this very different agreement with his worker –David Torjaman. David- a United Hatzalah volunteer has been working in the meat shop for almost two years now; he helps run the store and makes the hundreds of weekly deliveries as well. David is also known in Jerusalem for his life saving work as he responds to tens of calls per month.

“The problem came up when I noticed that unfortunately there are many so emergency calls a day, when I receive a call while at work I am in a big dilemma, on the one hand how can I not respond to an emergency which is two feet away? On the other hand as I do get paid by the hour and an emergency call takes time to respond to I am being dishonest with my boss ...”

And so, after many emergency calls while at work David decided to speak to his boss.

“I know Hatzalah volunteers for many years, their work is unbelievable” says yussie haker , owner of the store, “when I took David in to work with me I know he was a volunteer and would be responding to calls at work time, but when David came to me with his dilemma I realized it might prevent his from going out to life saving calls” Yossie explains “that is when we decided to have a written and signed contract where we both come out with tremendous profit” “Now I feel like a true partner in the life saving work around me” Yussie proudly concludes.

העובד יציל חיים בשעות העבודה - הבוס יקבל את המצווה

תשכיר מאנאל'ים הסכם ראשון מסוגו נחתם השבוע בין דוד תורגמן, מתנדב בארגון איחוד הצלה, לבין יוסי הקר, מעסיקו. על פי ההסכם, הקר יאפשר לתורגמן לצאת להציל חיים על הסכנו שעות העבודה בכל מה שיהיה לו צורך, ובתמורה יעניק לו חלק מזכויות המצווה על הצלת חיים. "בשורה כזו לא רק שאני יוצא נשמי, אני גם מרוויח יותר ממה שיכולתי להרוויח בכל שנותיי", אמר הקר. תנות למספר שמי יוקר בשבת נוח יעסק הוא מסר מסר כשר, ולקחת יזעמים כי בעלי הסכם הוא איש עסקים ורבינות. הסכם חתם רדי כי הקר לא חתם רק על עסקאות טרום הב שר וכו לאחיזה חתם על הסכם שנת החדש. תורגמן, הסיר כסלם, עובד בנות כשר שנתיים בהפעלת הסקים ובשליחויות. בזמן השנה הוא מתנדב כחור חובש ומגיש עזרה ראשונה מסוג כשר בארץ ובארצות אחרות הצלה. העצה התעוררה, לדברי, כשהיו סיריאת החדשים ורבות המתקבלות לא פסק בשעות הע' הרה. "ישנאן בנות עליו להתמודד עם ריח מה קשה מדי אחר אני כשיל חיים, אך מדי מני ים השם לגינות מספר המעשים שלי שמי של על שעות עבודתי", מסביר תורגמן. לאור זה שאירעו מקרי חירום רבים בשעות העבודה, החליט תורגמן לזרם עם הקר בנסיגה. "שמעתי את דוד לעבודה, ידעתי שישא מתנדב להצלה זה לא בהכרח, זה לא המניע לי כי אני מביט בעד של הצלה חי ארץ, אפי הקר, להרבות, כשהורגנו הסביר לי את

היילומט, הבין שיש השם מתנדבי ייאלץ לקר על פחות קריאת חירום כדי לא לפגוע באזור שביניהם, אף שחלילה הוא יחזק מדי בשנת השפועל. הראשוני מדי להגיע מחדש להגות". הקר חתם, הציג עסקת תורגמן יוכל לצאת לקריאת גם בזמן העבודה תמורה לבן שיקר יורה שותף ליבסי הצעות. "אני יכול להציל חיים בלי לחשוב בגינות

New Year - New accident

The morning of the New Year began with an emergency call at the entrance to the city of Elaad on road number 444.

Although the early hour 5:26AM United Hatzalah volunteers from Elaad rushed to the scene, nothing prepared them for what they saw. over 20 people needed to be treated, four were dead , 16 were treated by United Hatzalah volunteers and were sent to the hospital , five of which were in critical condition.

The volunteers worked in almost complete darkness until all the injured were evacuated to the hospital.

As it turned out a minivan slammed into a car causing the many injurious and fatalities. Those who were killed were Palestinian workers on the way to work in Israel.

Thank you to all who have given us the opportunity to continue our work.
